

Release Notes: StahlDat SX Data Module for GRANTA MI

September 2015 Release

The StahlDat SX data module for GRANTA MI incorporates the complete Register of European Steels (known as the "Stahl-Eisen-Liste" in German) augmented with composition, mechanical properties, material forms, and suppliers, plus temperature-dependent properties for many steels.

What's new in this release?

We have updated the Stahldat SX data module to ensure it contains the complete and up-to-date Register of European Steels, with specification data and temperature-dependent material properties. The latest version includes:

- 18 new grades
- 7 new standards
- 3 new suppliers

How can installing this release help you?

- Up-to-date access to the Register of European Steels information
- Make comparisons, find substitute materials and identify available forms and suppliers of metallic materials

System requirements

This release of the **StahlDat SX** data module is compatible with GRANTA MI Version 7 and later.

of these using MI:Admin before installing the new database, and then import the exporters into the new version of the database. Refer to Section 5.9 of the *GRANTA MI Administrator's Guide* for additional information.

- If you have added or modified any of the unit systems for this data module, you will need to replicate these changes in MI:Admin for the new version.
- If you have added or modified any layouts for this data module for use with MI:Explore, you will need to replicate these changes in MI:Admin for the new version.
